Property Maintenance

The Borough follows the International Property
Maintenance Code for property maintenance. The
International Property Maintenance Code is a model
code that regulates the minimum maintenance
requirements for existing buildings and exterior property
areas. The purpose of the Property Maintenance
Program is to protect the health, safety and welfare
of the public by requiring existing structures and
premises to comply with the provisions of the Property
Maintenance Code, and if such structures or premises
do not comply, the structure or premises shall be
required to be altered or repaired to provide a minimum
level of health and safety as required by the Code.

The responsibility for maintenance, falls on the owners, operators and occupants of the property. The Property Maintenance Code, provides requirements which are intended to maintain a minimum level of safety and sanitation for both the general public and the occupants of a structure, and to maintain a building's structural and

weather-resistance performance. The Code provides specific criteria for regulating the following:

- Installation and maintenance of specific building components
- Maintenance requirements for vacant structures and land
- Requirements regulating the safety, sanitation and appearance of the interior and exterior of structures and all exterior property areas
- · Accessory structures
- · Vehicle storage regulations

The Code also establishes who is responsible for complying with the chapter's provisions including the responsible parties for exterminating insects and rodents and maintaining sanitary conditions, in all types of occupancies.

The Borough employees monitor the exterior of properties throughout the year, but the Property Maintenance Enforcement Officer performs borough wide inspections from late Spring through Fall, to ensure the proper maintenance of the properties in the Borough. If we identify an issue which needs addressed, a written notice will be placed on your door allowing sufficient time to correct the issue.

Paxtang Borough will be installing another stormwater BMP near the intersection of Park Terrace and Brookwood Street. This Best Management Practice infiltration basin will be similar to the one completed near Park Terrace and Prince Street last year but on a smaller scale with a minimal number of trees being removed.

Similar to last years project, this project is planned, to meet the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4), requirements that the federal government has specified for municipalities. During each 5-year permit period we are required to meet certain standards and make improvements to our water quality. BMPs are structural, vegetative or managerial practices used to treat, prevent or reduce water pollution. They also help control flooding, reduce erosion and capture sediment while filtering the water on site.
